Application form:

The International Relations Office of the home university nominates students to Maria-Angélina BEAUCOURT and sends the application documents for her attention.

- Letter (one page) introducing yourself and stating the reasons for applying to CPE Lyon (in French)

- Liability insurance
- Proof of language proficiency (B1 required). The proof can be an official test but also a certification from the Head of language department
