ENROLLMENT

Specific conditions	 Students are required to choose one subject area (please, see the list of subject areas in the box Schools). All enrolled courses must belong to the chosen subject area. Students will not be allowed to enroll courses from a different subject area or school. Important exceptions! The subject area of "Communication" will have course-packs. All students who choose this area will be required to choose one of the set packs (also shown in the course catalogue). Students are not able to mix and match subjects from different packs! School of Architecture, Engineering, Arts and Design: All students in this school will be able to enroll courses from any subject area in this school, provided they meet the prerequisites. 	
Maximum ECTS	Coordinator at UEM.There is a maximum number of ECTS credits that can be selected depending on the duration of stay at UE Madrid Bachelor's Degrees that run on a trimester basis: 1 Trimester:24 ECTS2 Trimesters:36 ECTS3 Trimesters:60 ECTS Bachelor's Degrees that run on a semester basis: (Medicine; Dentistry)1 Semester:30 ECTS2 Semesters:60 ECTSImportant exception!Students will be able to sign up for a fee-paying, 6ECTS Spanish Course on top of this. There will be an Intensive Spanish Course before the start of Trimester 1 and courses during all three trimesters.
