1. Grading systems of the institutions

UK WOLVERH 01: The University of Wolverhampton has adopted the Credit Accumulation and Transfer system (CATS) of 120 credits for academic level of study. This is based on 6 x 20 credit modules per level. 1 credit is attributed with 10hrs of study. 20 CATS credits is equal to 10 ECTS credits. Therefore a full year's Undergraduate study is awarded 120 CATS credits, which is 60 ECTS credits.
