all test in one or the other Language.

to handle this situation.
The purpose of this email is to remind your students about it and ask them to
be prepared for it.

students next academic year 2016/2017 should have a diploma B1 in Spanish or
Catalan (one or the other) before registering at our online application.

requirement, but we'll like to emphasize the necessity to improve the quality
of our studies by going every year a step forward.
The B1 (Spanish or Catalan) Diploma therefore is a must for applying
successfully to an ERASMUS programme at the University of Barcelona Medical
School.
