Language of Instruction	French
Language Requirements	The Institute for French as a Foreign Language (IRFFLE) accepts beginners in their program. Students not planning on enrolling in IRFFLE are asked to provide proof of proficiency in French attested by the French department at their home university or an official test/certificate with the student's level of proficiency.

	In order to ensure that students complete their coursework successfully, a minimum score of B1 as defined by the Council of Europe is required in order to study abroad at Université de Nantes. Some departments require the students to have a score of B2 or higher.
	French embassies and consulates are increasingly demanding proof of proficiency in French. Students need to verify what may be required.
French Support Classes for Exchange Students	Offered free of charge for exchange students. Classes are organized twice a week in the evening. Students wishing to take French support classes need to fill out the request form available on our website.
	Exchange students can take an intensive language class, free of charge, at the beginning of the first semester (September).

Visa requirements

Are exchange students required to obtain a student visa?	Students must contact the French consular or Campus France services in their country of residence at least 3 months before their departure to find out about visa requirements. Generally, if the stay in France lasts for more than three months, the students must obtain a long-term student visa before their arrival in France. Citizens from the European Union, the European Economic Area, Andorra, Monaco, San Marino, Switzerland, and the Vatican are not required to obtain a visa to study in France. Students who are part of the ERASMUS+ program but who are not citizens of one of the above mentioned entities must obtain a visa. Foreigners residing in any of the following territories: European Union, the European Economic Area, Andorra, Monaco, San Marino, Switzerland, and the Vatican, are allowed to stay a maximum of 90 days in France. Therefore, they must obtain a visa before coming to France.
Are exchange students allowed to work?	The type of visa that students obtain before they arrive in France determines whether or not they are allowed to work. Students who are allowed to work in France must finish the procedure for the residency permit before starting to work. Foreign students are only allowed to work 964 hours per year (i.e) approximately 20 - 21 hours per week, with the exception of academic holidays when they can work full time).

Insurance <u>and</u> "Sécurité Sociale"

Are exchange students required to purchase health coverage upon arrival?	All European Union students must have their European health card. Non-European students must pay 214€ for social security (French national health coverage) when they enrol at the university.

Do exchange students need to take out any other insurance plans upon their arrival?	Yes. All students must purchase <u>room insurance</u> when they arrive in Nantes and before they can move into their rooms. <u>Civil liability insurance</u> is also mandatory for all exchange students. Room insurance and civil liability insurance can be purchased as a package at Guichet Unique.
Is medical service provided on campus? @SUMMPS	All students registered at the université de Nantes have free access to the university health service (Service santé-sociale étudiant: SUMPPS). An appointment is mandatory. For more information: http://www.univ-nantes.fr/sante
