will use the following grading system and ECTS grade conversion from February 2015.

F. Information / 1. Grading system of the institution

The University of Miskolc follows the ECTS scheme, which means that ECTS credits are allocated to course units, lectures, practical work, etc. at each faculty. In ECTS, 60 credits represent one year of study (in terms of workload); normally 30 credits are given for one semester (5 months).
