



NOVA School of Science and Technology (FCT) introduced a new requirement for students willing to do Erasmus mobility in our institution. At NOVA FCT, the language of instruction is Portuguese. At FCT starting in 2020/2021 academic year students will be required to present a language certificate during the application, B1 of English OR A2 of Portuguese. However, in order to communicate adequately and to attend classes successfully during your study period, we highly recommend B2 of English
