The enrollment must be done after acceptence/enrollment at our school and before the start date of the course. The course has limited vacancies, and only the first 20 students who applie can be accepted.

	Application procedures	Application deadlines
Erasmus period of studies	Students selected and nominated, by their home institution, for an Erasmus period of studies at Faculdade de Ciências must submit an application - mandatory for all students.  After submitting this application students should send a Learning Agreement for Studies, duly approved by their home institution, for analysis.	Applications are online but Learning Agreements can be sent by post or e-mail to the Mobility Office of Faculdade de Ciências da Universidade de Lisboa, before the following deadlines:  1st Semester/Annual: 30th June 2019 2nd Semester: 31st October 2019
Erasmus placement	If you are interested in doing an Erasmus placement /project in a research group of Faculdade de Ciências, you should do the following:  1. Find a Research Centre or Group in which you are interested in. 2. Contact directly the Centre and ask for an official acceptance. 3. If you have been accepted by the Research Centre, then contact the Mobility Office informing us of the name of the supervisor and Centre.	You should contact the Faculty of Sciences International/Mobility Office already with the official acceptance from a supervisor and research centre at least two months before the start of your Erasmus placement.

# **Additional information**

Language requirements and teaching language	Exchange students coming to the Faculty of Sciences are required to have, at least the A2 level (according to the CEFR) of Portuguese which is essential to properly attend lectures, mostly taught in this language.  Students who do not have this level of Portuguese are strongly recommended to attend a Portuguese language course before arrival and during their stay.  A good knowledge of English is also necessary (B1 is the minimum required level, which must be certified).  Bear in mind that all our BSc level courses are taught in Portuguese. MSc level courses might be lectured in English in case there is a non-Portuguese speaking student in class.  Examination in English should be arranged with each Professor.  The presentation of certificates and/or attested statements is compulsory:  A2 level for Portuguese; and/or B1 level for English  Each application will be analyzed individually and your proposed plan of studies
	will be evaluated accordingly with your presented language level.
Portuguese language courses	ULisboa organizes <b>Portuguese Language Courses</b> for Erasmus Students in the beginning of each semester. Courses take place at the <u>School of Arts and Humanities</u> of Universidade de Lisboa.
