3. Additional requirements

The sending university will screen and select candidates for exchange studies in accordance with its applicable rules and regulations. The candidates of the contracting institutions will use the required application form of the receiving institution. The receiving institution will accept the candidates selected by the sending institution if mutually acceptable academic and/or professional qualifications and standards are met. However, the receiving university has the right to make the final decision on the admission of candidates nominated for exchange. Admission to a specific course is subject to the exchange student being satisfactorily qualified for the chosen area of study and/or course level, and availability.

The exchange students will be subject to the laws and regulations of the country and the university where the student is currently studying or is under direct supervision.

4. Calendar

4.1 Applications/information on nominated students must reach SLund01 by:

Autumn term	1-25 april
Spring term	1-25 oct

4.2 Decision

The receiving institution will send its decision within 10 weeks.

4.3 Transcript of records

A Transcript of Records will be issued no later than 10 weeks after the assessment period has finished at S Lund01.

4.4 Termination of Agreement

[It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the interinstitutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September in any year will only take effect as of 1 September the following year. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer. However, any exchange in progress will continue until completed: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."
