2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 3 weeks.

3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.

4. Termination of the agreement

Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this Agreement will, in the first instance, be referred to the Erasmus Co-ordinators for discussion and resolution within 10 Working Days after the date on which it is so referred.

This Agreement may be terminated at any time by mutual consent of the parties in writing, or by either party by 1 September for the following academic year. Students or faculty actively participating in the programme at the time of termination may continue through to the end of the agreed mobility period in progress.

Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
