Cost of living	<p>The minimum financial resources students should have available are 6000-8000 CZK (250-400€) per month. The recommended amount of money is 400€ per month.</p> <p>Tuition fees are waived for all Erasmus+ students, however all students must pay some fees.</p>				
Accommodation	<p>Student housing is available through the University Housing or by private let.</p> <p>Erasmus+ students may be eligible to receive a housing subsidy of approximately. 30 €/month, <u>application deadline is 30.10.2018.</u></p> <p>Prices can range from 1 835 CZK (68€) for triple occupancy, 2 000 CZK (75€) for a double and 2 290 CZK (85€) for a single (the quoted prices include energy and services).</p>				
Meals	<p>Lunch at the university canteen costs between 65-98 CZK (3-5€) and is obtained at the "Kampus Palace" located in the center of town.</p> <p>Meals are ordered with the University Student ID card and must be charged with adequate funds.</p>
