5/ Exchange students:

How to apply: application form (<https://tlse2.moveon4.com/locallogin/55928f563f5d663d20000000/eng>) sent by the home institution which nominates exchange students.

Nomination/Application deadlines: May 31st (1st semester) and October 31st (2nd semester) for nomination and application. Official nomination has to be received from the Home Institution's International Office.

Recommended arrival dates: October 1st (1st semester) and January 21st (2nd semester)

International student orientation: 1st to 12th of October (1st semester) and January (2nd semester)

6/ Practical information:

French courses: The department of French as a Foreign Language (DEFLE Département d'Etude du Français Langue Étrangère) offers courses for non-native French speakers in order to improve their knowledge of the French language.

Housing: housing is available if students fill an application at the International Office by the publish deadline.

Health and Medical Insurance: if the student is European, no needs to be register at the "Sécurité Sociale", non-European students have to be registered at the "Sécurité Sociale".

Visa and Immigration: it is the students' responsibility to get informed and apply for a visa at the French embassy of their home country

Expenses: budget for a student in France is around 750€ per months (housing, transport, food, outing...).

The University of Toulouse creates the Handbook Ariane (available in 4 languages) to sum all these piece of information.
