PLEASE NOTE: Students who have already benefited from an Erasmus scholarship (even during previous degree courses) without gaining credits, may submit an application, but priority will be given to candidates who have not yet participated in the programme and who have listed the same organisation as a preference.

DOUBLE DEGREES

- Under the qualification recognition programme between the University of Genoa and the Université Côte d'Azur (UCA), the four 12-month scholarships at the University of Nice are reserved, in the first instance, for master's students participating in the aforesaid programme.
- Under the qualification recognition programme between the University of Genoa and Leuphana Universität Lüneburg, the five 10-month scholarships at Leuphana Universität Lüneburg are reserved, in the first instance, for master's students participating in the aforesaid programme.

DEDICATED DESTINATIONS

Destinations dedicated (but not exclusively) to students on courses in **Teorie e tecniche della mediazione interlinguistica (TTMI - L12)** [Interlinguistic mediation theories and techniques] and **Traduzione e interpretariato (LM94)** [Translation and Interpreting].
