DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION SCIENCES (DISFOR)

- Applicants are required to attend an interview. If appropriately documented in the opinion of the Committee, any inability to attend for interview will not be grounds for exclusion from the selection.
- Students are required to have passed at least one exam in their study plan.
- The Selection Committee will also consider the consistency between the study programme available at the assigned organisation, which the student is required to verify, for all chosen organisations, and the programme to be completed as part of the student's course.

Further to an agreement with CLAT, all students who submit an application must have verified their language skills by taking an English test and a test in a further two languages from among French, German, Spanish and Portuguese. The Selection Committees may reduce the score assigned to students based on their language skills if they have not taken the test set by the CLAT or have not received a statement from it relating to their language skills. In order to assess skills in languages for which no test is available, the Committees may arrange tests to verify these language skills during the interview or assess any certificates uploaded in PDF format during the application procedure. Any language assessments passed by the student as part of his/her course will not exempt the student from taking the English language assessment test.
